

HIGHWAYS PARKING ENFORCEMENT AT BRABAZON

From Monday 1st June parking management is being introduced at Brabazon. This will be implemented in two stages: adoptable roads and pavements first, then the EV and visitor spaces on 3rd August, a follow up letter will be issued nearer to the time to confirm how those spaces will be managed. New signs will be installed on the street lighting columns which confirm the parking regulations. In the residential districts, parking will only be permitted in designated spaces – no parking will be accepted on the roads and pavements. For avoidance of doubt, this restriction includes the pavement in front of any garages – there are no garage drives at Brabazon.

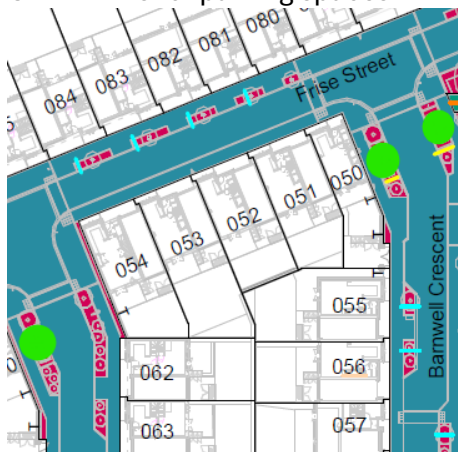
To help with the transition, for the first 10 days of June UK CPM will only issue a written warning when parking conditions have been breached. **From the 11 June, any breaches will receive a Penalty Charge Notice with a fine of £100 (which reduces to £60 if settled within 14 days).**

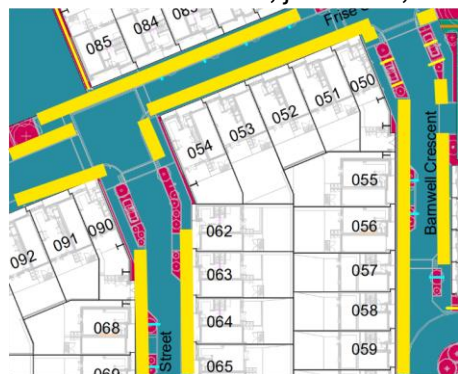
Examples of areas where parking is permitted.

GREEN: Visitor parking spaces



Examples of areas where parking is NOT permitted.

YELLOW: Pavements, junctions, and kerbs



Runway Avenue: As this is the main route through Brabazon it will be a Red Route Clearway. This means no stopping is permitted at any time.
